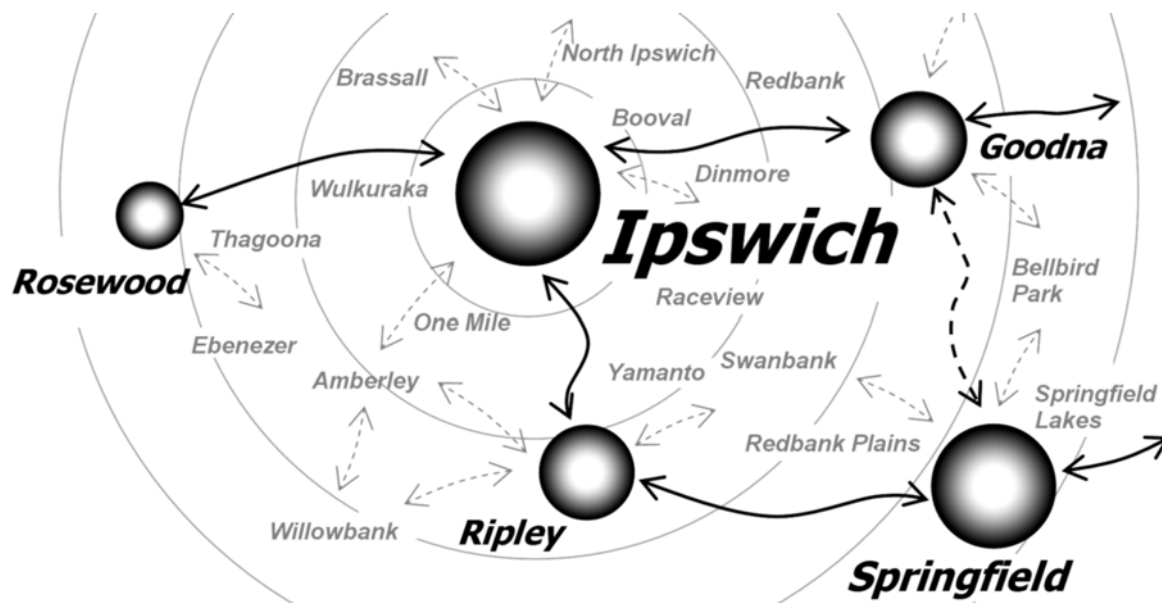


Forum – 5 February 2008, Barry Jones Auditorium (Free Entry, All Welcome)
