Pre-paid service

CityGlider is a fully pre-paid service to reduce boarding times and get you where you want to go sooner. Passengers must have a valid ticket (single, daily, weekly or monthly) or go card prior to boarding.

You can buy and top up a go card online, at go card retailers including most 7-Eleven stores, at selected train stations or by calling TransLink on 13 12 30. You can buy a paper ticket at most train stations and selected agents.
