



Changes to routes 77, P88 and 111

The first stage of the Brisbane City Council bus network review changes will be implemented on **Monday 22 July**.

Route 77 off-peak timetable changes

Off-peak route 77 services (Chermside to Eight Mile Plains via CLEM7 tunnel) will change, running hourly instead of half hourly, to better match customer demand.

You still have plenty of fast and frequent travel options between Eight Mile Plains and Chermside:

- Take the high frequency route 111 to Roma Street or King George Square busway stations, then catch route 333, 330 or 340 to Chermside bus station. Too easy!

Peak hour services will still run every 15 minutes.

Route 111 minor timetable changes

Minor timetable changes will be made to **route 111** (Eight Mile Plains to Roma Street) to provide more consistent running times.

You'll still have the same number of services on the 111—just at slightly different times.

That said, route 111 is so frequent there's no need for a timetable. Just turn up and go!

Route P88 removal

Route P88 (Eight Mile Plains to Indooroopilly via City) will be removed to address duplication with other high frequency buses on the South East Busway and Coronation Drive.

You'll still have plenty of other high frequency travel options to get you where you need to go:

Toowong	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• route 111 to Roma Street or King George Square busway stations, then transfer to route 444• route 111 to King George Square busway stations, then transfer to route 412 at Adelaide St stop 16• route 111 to Roma Street station, then transfer to an Ipswich or Richlands line train.
The Wesley Hospital	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• route 411 or 433 from Adelaide Street stop 40, or route 430 from Queen Street bus station• high frequency routes 412 (Adelaide Street stop 16) or 444 (Roma Street or King George Square busway stations)• an Ipswich or Richlands line train from Central or Roma Street stations to Auchenflower station.
Brisbane Boys' College (Moggill Road stop 16)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• routes 425, 430, 433, 435, 444, 453 or 460 from Indooroopilly bus station or the City• an Ipswich or Richlands line train from Roma Street or Central stations (or an inbound train from Indooroopilly) to Toowong station.

We'll keep you informed well in advance of any changes as we work with Brisbane City Council to implement the Brisbane bus network review.
