### Summary of changes

Route Number	Nature of changes
101	To provide improved local access, this route will be <b>significantly realigned</b> (see map). The new route will travel from Forest Lake Village to Richlands station seven days a week, and on to Oxley station on weekdays only. This route will no longer service Corinda station.  To travel along the old route between Inala Plaza and Blunder Road, you can catch a high frequency route 100.
102	Due to low patronage this route will no longer service Corinda station. It will now <b>terminate at Oxley station</b> (see map). You can catch high frequency train services between these stations or catch route 106 to nearby stops.
103	This route will include a loop from Darra station to Centenary Village (see map) at peak times, replacing route 462.
118	This route will be <b>slightly realigned</b> to provide improved services to passengers along College Avenue and follow a more logical route through Forest Lake (see map). <b>Passengers who board along Forest Lake Boulevard, Lochwood Avenue, Woogaroo Street and Grand Avenue will need to catch the bus from the opposite side of the road.  This route will no longer stop at Eight Mile Plains to reduce overcrowding.</b>
460	This route will be <b>significantly realigned</b> , now terminating at Parkwood Drive, Heathwood. It will no longer service Inala Plaza or College Avenue. Inala Plaza passengers can catch the new 101 to Richlands station and transfer to a train to the CBD, or catch the new 101 to Forest Lake Boulevard and transfer to the 460. College Avenue passengers can catch the new 118 to the CBD. This route will operate more services at peak times and extra short services from Heathwood to Richlands station in the early morning and afternoon to connect with trains.
P461	To minimise route duplication, the P461 will be removed. You can catch the upgraded route 460, with extra services at peak times (see above). Passengers along College Avenue can catch the new 101 to Forest Lake Village and transfer to the 460.
462	To minimise route duplication this route will be removed. To travel between Richlands and Heathwood you can catch the new 460. To travel between Darra and Centenary Village you can catch route 103 at peak times.
465	To minimise route duplication this route will be removed. You can catch the upgraded 460 which has additional trips and services Richlands station, Forest Lake and Heathwood.
466	To minimise route duplication this route will be removed. This route is already serviced in part by route 122 and 110, which aren't changing. To travel to Richlands station you can transfer to the new 101 at Inala Plaza.
468	The hours of operation of this route will be reduced to better match customer demand. Services will operate between 9am and 7.30pm on weekdays only, and services will no longer operate on weekends or public holidays.
